- ELIGIBLE WORKS: Music by 20th and 21st century composers. All disciplines may participate.
- FEE: \$20.00 per entry. (Duets/Ensembles = one entry.)
 - O Students of MTAC teachers may enter the festival in more than one discipline but will be required to include separate entry fees and applications for each performance. No preparatory level students. Teachers, please collect fees from students and include one check only, made out to SCVMTAC, with your studio packet. There is a ten (10) student limit per studio. Extra entries can be submitted and will be used as space and time permits. *Please number your extra entries in order of preference.*
 - This event is for elementary, junior high and high school age students. There is a time limit of 5 minutes for levels 1-7 and 7 minutes for levels 8 and above.
- **DEADLINE**: Send checks to Madeline Miller, 25809 Lochmoor Road, Valencia, CA 91355, in hand by October 23 or postmarked by October 21, 2017. Please enclose only one check including amounts for extra entries. Online entry forms without payment will not be considered for the Festival. The online entry forms are found on the branch website, mtacscybranch.org.
- **DRESS CODE:** Concert Dress is required for performance in the Festival.
 - o **GIRLS:** Dress or skirt and top. Dress or skirt must be long enough to sufficiently cover upper leg when standing, sitting or bending over to adjust piano bench. Tights may be worn under dresses or skirts. When in doubt, longer is best. Tops must completely cover the waist including the back when seated. Shoes must be appropriate to allow walking up steps and pedaling.
 - o **BOYS:** Dress slacks, dress shoes, collared shirt and tie. Suits are also acceptable.
 - BOYS AND GIRLS: No jeans, athletic shoes or flip-flops. Clothing should be dressy rather than casual. In general, dress should not detract from the performance.
 - Students dressed inappropriately will not be allowed to perform.
- **FALL FESTIVAL WINNERS 2017:** The top 20-25% of Fall Festival participants will be selected by the adjudicators as winners and receive trophies.
- **COMMENT SHEETS**: Available to teachers Monday, November 13th at the home of Madeline Miller.
- **REMINDER:** Students and parents must stay for the entire recital in which they are scheduled. Sick children will not be allowed to perform and will be sent home. Please no babies or toddlers.
