- ELIGIBLE WORKS: PUBLISHED works by 20th and 21st c. composers. All disciplines may participate and all genres of music is acceptable. MEMORIZATION IS <u>NOT</u> MANDATORY, however, 5 points will be granted to those who do memorize their music. Students will be judged on how well they perform, regardless of level. <u>Please bring a score or part for the adjudicators.</u>
  - This event is for elementary, junior high and high school age students. No preparatory level entries, please. There is a time limit of 5 minutes for levels
    1-7 and 7 minutes for levels 8 and above.
- FEE: \$25.00 per SOLO entry. \$10.00 each ADDITIONAL participant (\$35 for duet, \$45 for trio...)
  - Students of MTAC teachers may enter the festival in more than one discipline, but will be required to include separate entry fees and applications for each performance. Teachers, please collect fees from students and include one check only, made out to SCVMTAC, along with a list of participants. There is a ten (10) student limit per studio. Extra entries can be submitted and will be used as space and time permits. Please number your extra entries in order of preference.
- DEADLINE: Send checks to Jean DeMart, 29018 Raintree Lane, Saugus, CA 91390, in hand by November 2nd or postmarked by November 1st. Please enclose only one check, including amounts for extra entries. Online entry forms without payment will not be considered for the Festival. The online entry forms are found on the branch website, mtacscvbranch.org.
- DRESS CODE: Concert Dress is required for performance in the Festival.
  - ➤ GIRLS: Dress or skirt and top. Dress or skirt length should be long enough to cover upper legs when standing, sitting or bending over to adjust piano bench. Tights may be worn under dresses or skirts. When in doubt, longer is better. Shoes must be appropriate for pedaling and walking up steps.

- > BOYS: Dress slacks, dress shoes, collared shirt and tie. Suits are also acceptable
- FESTIVAL WINNERS 2019: The top 25-30% of Festival participants will be selected by the adjudicators as winners and receive trophies.
- COMMENT SHEETS: Available to teachers Monday, Nov. 18th at the home of Jean DeMart.
