- 1. Video recording should be good quality, but does not need to be professionally produced.
- 2. Video recordings must be made with one fixed camera angle. The performer's face and hands must be clearly visible throughout the recording. If possible, please include feet in the frame as well.
- 3. The video must be recorded in one unedited take. Any evidence of multiple takes, or of audio that does not match the performance will result in disqualification.
- 4. Important!! Do not include the name of the performer in the video. However, include the following in your email

Name of the performer -- composer's first initial & last name, opus #, Key, mvt

Eg) Mary Smith -- M. Clementi Sonatina op. 35, No.3 in C Major, Spiritoso

- 5. Use the landscape mode for the video shot. However, CM recording video can be used if not planning to record again.
- 6. No bowing, no introduction but just playing only.
