- ★ ELIGIBLE WORKS: PUBLISHED works by 20th and 21st c. composers in ORIGINAL FORM no arrangements. All disciplines may participate, and all genres of music is acceptable. It is open to all pianists and instrumentalists. There will be a NON PIANO category for the instrumentalists. Accompaniment is optional but PLEASE, no pre-recorded accompaniment. Bring an ORIGINAL score or part for the adjudicators and an original part for yourself, if needed. NO PHOTOCOPIES ALLOWED.
- ★ PARTICIPATION: Students of MTAC teachers, grades pre-K through High School, all instruments.
- ★ JUDGING: Students will be judged on how well they perform on their instrument, according to their level. This year, there will be several categories:

Early Elementary: Levels Prep to 1 (2 minute time limit)

Elementary: Levels 2 to 3 (4 minute time limit)

Intermediate: Levels 4 to 5 (5 minute time limit)

Early Advanced: Levels 6 to 7 (6 minute time limit)

Advanced: Levels 8 and able (7 minute time limit)

NON PIANO: All levels, unless we have an unusually high number of participants.

MEMORIZATION OF MUSIC IS <u>NOT</u> MANDATORY; however, <mark>5 extra points will be granted by each judge to those who do memorize their music (10pts. total). Winners will be announced in each category <u>and receive trophies or ribbons.</u> In addition, <u>the top 10%</u> will be named <u>OVERALL FESTIVAL WINNER</u>.</mark>

- ★ Per LA County restrictions on indoor gatherings due to COVID 19, the SCVMTAC requires that only a limited number of participants, parents, MTAC teachers, and judges shall be permitted in the recital hall. Live Zoom will be available for those who wish to watch from elsewhere.
- FEE: \$30 per SOLO entrant (add \$15 for each additional participant). Ensembles of up to 3 participants will be allowed on stage to allow for allow for proper spacing restrictions. Teachers, please collect fees from students and write one check only, made out to SCVMTAC, along with a list of participants.
- ★ DEADLINE: Teachers, send checks to Jean DeMart, 29018 Raintree Lane, Saugus, CA 91390, postmarked by OCTOBER 31st, or you can drop off at Little School of Music, front desk. Please enclose only one check per studio. Online entry forms must be filled out, and are found on the branch website, mtacscvbranch.org.
- ★ DRESS CODE: Concert dress is required for performance in the festival. Girls: Dress or skirt and top. Boys: Dress slacks, collared shirt, and tie. **NO FLIPFLOPS OR SNEAKERS, PLEASE.**
